THE HEART'S DESIRE takes as its source the six 15th-century tapestries known as The Lady and the Unicorn. Each of the first five tapestries is thought to depict one of the senses, while the sixth bears the enigmatic inscription À Mon Seul Desir (To My One Desire). Its meaning is much debated and various interpretations have been put forward: the assertion of free will, the renunciation of worldly passions, or an internal, sixth sense—'understanding'—located in the heart.

CAFÉ REASON is an experimental performance group specialising in butoh – the iconoclastic dance form that originated in post-war Japan. Since its establishment in 1997, the group has achieved a fine reputation for its innovative theatre, site-specific, and improvised performances.
